

**SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING
CITY OF SHELL LAKE
June 23, 2021**

City Council President Ken Schultz called the meeting to order at 5:00 PM. Council members present were Stephen Smith, Deb Nebel, Rob Anderson, Mike Andrews and Rowie Hansberger. Mayor Peterson, Dan Harrington and Brian Carlson were absent. Andy Eiche was also present.

The council discussed the idea of moving the City Council meetings back to the council chambers at City Hall. Nebel reminded the council that if situations worsen in the future, the council could reverse its decision. Anderson felt the decision to approve would be consistent with other decisions already being made. Nebel moved, seconded by Anderson, to conduct future city council meetings in-person at the Shell Lake council chambers. The motion passed 5 – 1, with Smith being the opposing vote.

The council discussed the request for a Temporary Class “B” Retailer’s License for the Shell Lake Chamber of Commerce to operate the July 3rd Street Dance.

Smith moved, seconded by Hansberger, to approve the Temporary Class “B” Retailer’s License for the Shell Lake Chamber of Commerce to operate the July 3rd Street Dance. Upon unanimous vote, the motion carried.

Andrews moved, seconded by Nebel, to approve the July 3rd Street Use Permit requested by the Shell Lake Chamber of Commerce. Upon unanimous vote, the motion carried.

Smith moved, seconded by Harrington, to adjourn at 5:23 p.m. Meeting adjourned.
