

**REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING
CITY OF SHELL LAKE
August 10, 2026**

Mayor Rowie Hansberger called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Council members present were Terry Severson, Stephen Smith, Mike Andrews, Steve Byrd, Rob Anderson, Ken Schultz, Dan Harrington and Tom Rasmussen. Andy Eiche, Mitch Brown, Mike Jaszczak, Emma Adkison, Kyle Scherhaug, Reagan Kohler and Bob Hapy were also present.

Rasmussen moved, seconded by Schultz, to approve the council minutes from July 13, 2026. Motion carried unanimously.

Public Comment: None.

Brown presented the Public Works Director report. Hansberger praised the Public Works department for the work they did to prepare the roads for the triathlon.

Jaszczak presented a police report.

Hansberger presented the Zoning Administrator report.

Mayor's Report: Hansberger noted how well the triathlon had gone with 239 participants and \$30,000 in revenue. Hansberger also noted a recent article in the Spooner Advocate addressing the balloon waste left behind from the annual boat parade. She urged everyone to take the time to read the article and see the importance in discontinuing the activity in the future.

General Administration: Andrews presented the General Administration minutes. Schultz moved, seconded by Smith, to change city policy to allow any prospective employee/officer to go on a ride along with any officer that would be willing to take the ride along with them and to experience taking calls for service so they can better see what we do and how we operate the department. And, the individual must 18 years of age. Upon unanimous vote, the motion carried.

Public Works: Schultz presented the Public Works committee minutes.

Financial Administration: Smith presented the minutes. Smith moved, seconded by Severson, to approve vouchers 755-936. Motion carried unanimously.
